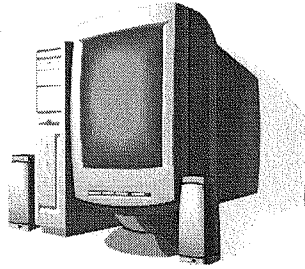
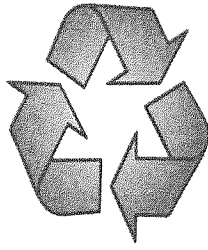

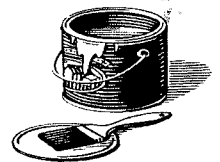

### Home :

- oil-based paint
- wood stain
- cleaning products
- paint thinner
- adhesives
- glues

### Yard, Garden & Garage:

- weed killer
- fertilizer
- pest poisons
- pool chemicals
- antifreeze
- deck sealer
- auto fluids

### Miscellaneous:

- fluorescent light bulbs & cfl's
- mercury thermometers
- batteries (not auto)
- aerosol cans

**-Latex paint is not accepted.**
