All homes in the township will be serviced on the **First Monday** of the month. Please remember to place your cart out the night before your scheduled pick-up.

Do

1. Rinse All Containers.
2. Leave caps on containers.
3. Break down cardboard boxes.
4. Check for recycling symbol and number on plastic material.
5. Place items loosely in cart.

Don't

1. Place items with any food or soiled material in recycling cart.
2. No Hazardous Waste in recycling. (engine oil, pesticide, paint, etc.)
3. Place any large plastic items in recycling. (plastic lawn chairs, five gallon bucket, etc.).
4. No Clothes.

Curbside Recycling

Martin Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service. Sign up by contacting Allegan County Resource Recovery at (269) 686-4559 or at the Martin Library.

These items are accepted:

- Cardboard
 - Paper, newsprint
 - Cartons
 - Glass bottles, jars
 - Plastic containers #1-7
 - Metal Cans & foil
- NO STYROFOAM!**

Regional Recycling Depots:

You must bring your Resource Recovery Card!



If you did not receive a 2019 Resource Recovery (Recycling) Card please contact Martin Township Hall at (269) 672-5027. This card is required to receive depot services.

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle **tires (4)**, **Styrofoam**, **appliances (2)** (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), **TV/Computer (1)** and **metal**.

These types of materials can be taken to the following locations on the first and third Saturdays of the month. (Closed Jan & Feb) :

- 1) **Allied Waste/Republic Recycling Station**, 3310 M-40 Hwy, Hamilton, open 9am-12noon.
- 2) **Salem Township Transfer Station**, 4145 29th Street, Dorr, open from 8:30am-3:30pm. (This site also provides a bulk trash service for a fee.)
- 3) **NEW Site** with expanded hours: **Broken Arrow Recycling**, 1100 Lincoln Rd, Allegan. Open M-F 9am-4:30pm, Sat. 9am-12pm. See flyer for more info at www.allegancounty.org, click "recycling."
